“This” y “that” son equivalentes a “esto” y “eso”, respectivamente.

- **This** pen is blue
- **That** chair is black
- **That** tree is tall

A and The

“A” es equivalente a “un/una” en Español, y “the” es equivalente a “el/la/los/las”.

- There is **a** chair here. **The** chair is grey.
- **There are** trees there. **The** trees are tall.
